A big construction crane, the universally understood symbol for "some serious shit's gonna get built here" has appeared in the massively under construction Miami Design District—future land of [untold luxuries](#) http://miami.curbed.com/archives/categories/design_district.php —along with another fairly widely understood symbol for the same thing, a closed street. **39th Street has been closed to traffic, perhaps to accommodate the crane.** To the left, the Buena Vista building is a shell of its old self while it gets a sleek modern upgrade. You can still see the outlines of the buildings little roof things from the 70s or 80s. To the right the Melin building remains untouched.
